Abstracts should be prepared using Microsoft Word or Corel Wordperfect and be contained in a box 4.75" (length) by 7.0" (width). Exceeding the size of the box may result in a loss of information.

The title should be in upper case and should be followed by the names of the authors and their institutional affiliation. The body of the abstract should begin with a four space indentation. Use a font that is easy to read and reproduce.

Below the abstract, you should indicate:

- 1 The name, telephone number and email address of the presenting author.
- 2 Whether the abstract is submitted for one of the competitions and to which competition the abstract has been submitted:
 - A Montford F Piercey Award and Duncan McCarthy Award
 - B Poster Award - Graduate Student
 - C Poster Award - Undergraduate Student
 - D Poster Award - Research Technicians/Associates.
3. Indicate the theme in which the poster should be placed:
 - A Development & Plasticity
 - B Cell Biology
 - C Neurotransmitters, Modulators, Synaptic Transmission,& Receptors
 - D Endocrine & Autonomic
 - E Motor Systems & Sensorimotor Integration
 - F Disorders of the Nervous System
 - G Behavioral Pharmacology

E-mail the file containing the abstract and requested information, as an attachment, to stockme1@msu.edu. The file should have the same name as the first author's last name.

Note: Poster width should be no more than 66". Push pins to attach posters to poster boards will be supplied.
